The fundamental, time-honored mitzvah of Mikvah is vital to the strength of the Jewish family, and therefore to Jewish continuity. Jewish law underscores the importance of the building of the Mikvah by requiring the sale even of Torah scrolls or a Synagogue to provide the funds if necessary.

Gothenburg's first Mikvah was built in 1989 upon the request of the Lubavitcher Rebbe.



Fact #1: Because of our very Northern location, Mikvah usage hours in Sweden during mid-summer reaches after midnight - especially on Motzei Shabbat!

Fact #2: This will be the only Mikvah in Scandinavia (Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Norway) built according to the Halachic specifications of "Bor Tachat Bor".

Fact #3: Visitors travel as far as 600 km. (400 miles) in one day, and even from neighboring countries, in order to go to Gothenburg's Mikvah. These include regulars, one time visitors and tourists.

The Goal: To build a new, modern and beautiful Mikva in a great location that would enhance and encourage the observance of this essential Mitzva.

The Mikvah will also be used as a Keilim Mikvah in connection to Kashrut classes taking place in the Chabad House, and a men's Mikvah during morning hours.
